Alexander Ullman

was born in 1991 in England and studied at the Purcell School of Music in Bushey under the guidance of the Head of Keyboard, William Fong. In 2009 he won a scholarship to the prestigious Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia, graduating last year. As a student he was chosen to perform a Mozart piano concert with the Philadelphia Symphony Orchestra. Last summer he performed the Schumann piano quintet with the Dover Quartet here at Weston as part of a European tour by Curtis Institute alumni.

Alexander has won numerous prizes and international competitions including first prize at the International Piano Competition in Memoriam Ferenc Liszt in Budapest, the Tunbridge Wells International Young Concert Artists Competition and the International Marlow Concerto Competition.

Following his success at the Liszt Competition Alexander has performed in a series of tours across Europe and Asia taking him to concert halls throughout England, Italy, Germany, Hungary, the Netherlands, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Denmark, India and China.

His programme for us will include works by Bach, Haydn and Beethoven, followed by Schubert and Chopin in the second half.
