## fontanella

Featuring some of the UK's most talented and respected recorder players, the recorder ensemble *Fontanella* is building a reputation as one of Britain's most innovative groups. The ensemble has appeared in concert all over the UK, and on radio and television networks across Britain and Europe, including concerts and festivals in London, Brighton, York, Iceland and Finland.

Fontanella's musical interests are wide and encompass all periods of music from medieval through to contemporary music. Their magnificent consort of renaissance instruments showcases historical research by the English recorder maker Adrian Brown. The ensemble is equally keen to increase the contemporary music repertoire for recorder quintet, resulting in the purchase of a consort of Paetzold 'square' recorders, and a number of new commissions.

Their programme for us, 'Pastime and Good Company', has been designed especially to demonstrate the whole range of recorder music from medieval to contemporary, and the complete range of the recorder family. They will play consort music by Henry VIII, Byrd and Holborne, complemented by music inspired by nature and the countryside by Vivaldi, Saint-Saens, Steve Marshall, Tim Coker and Johnny Mercer.
