The O Percussion Duo

Described by the Daily Telegraph as “brimming with style and panache” and “renowned for their phenomenal artistry” the O Duo have performed across the world. Highlights include performances both at the BBC Proms and at the Last Night of the Proms in Hyde Park. They are passionate both for commissioning new work and for encouraging children to enjoy classical music. They have been appointed artistic directors of the children’s classic concerts in Scotland.

This is their second visit to Weston; better known now than in 2008 they come to us following children’s concerts at the Royal Concert Hall Glasgow and the Usher Hall Edinburgh.

But don’t get the idea that this is just drumming! Oliver Cox and Owen Gunnell both graduated with first class honours from the Royal College of Music and have performed concertos with both the London Philharmonic and the Philharmonia. They are wonderful performers on melodic percussion instruments such as marimbas and vibraphones, enabling them to play a wide range of music from the classical repertoire. (The piano is a percussion instrument too!)
